Firearms with Adjustable Gas Blocks

ARIC selection is based on standard gas ports. Firearms with adjustable gas blocks with multiple settings may run the "C" Carrier suppressed and unsuppressed by adjusting the setting. Due to the variety of adjustable gas blocks on the market Law Tactical cannot provide specific recommendations.

Small-Port Dedicated Suppressed Firearms

Some firearms have been specifically designed and ported for suppressed usage ONLY. An indicator is a firearm that does not reliably function without a suppressor using a standard carrier. If your firearm is a small-port dedicated suppressed firearm, select the ARIC-C.

.300 Blackout

Many 300 Blackout firearms function properly with both "M" or "C" Carriers suppressed and unsuppressed. However, due to lack of standardization, ARIC may not reliably function with some combinations of ammunition, barrel, gas port, and suppressor.
