Medical Waiver Letter

Dear Applicant:

The Maryland State Police Licensing Division has reviewed your application for an Agency License and/or Handgun Permit. After this review, it was determined that you answered "YES" to questions regarding treatment by any doctor for a possible mental disorder, drug/alcohol addiction, or current treatment with prescribed narcotics. We have determined that you are **REQUIRED** to obtain certification from a medical practitioner OR the doctor who treated you for your medical issue/mental disorder/addiction.

The certification must be issued no more than 30 days prior to submission of your application. The certification must state that, in the medical practitioner's professional opinion, you are or have been successfully treated for the medical issue/mental disorder/addiction. The certification should contain the following statement **VERBATIM as following:**

"(Your Name) has been successfully treated or he/she is continuing to be treated, without incident"

The certification will NOT be accepted unless the above statement is included exactly as written above. Please do not submit a generic doctor's note or form letter for this certification, as it will not be accepted and your application will be further delayed.
